Alain Roy owns a famous estate, a property regularly cited as a standard-bearer for the village of Montagny, one of premium wine growing areas in southern Burgundy's Cote Chalonnaise. Alain Roy makes a wine worthy of the designation, from a site that has been acknowledged as among the region's finest for over 350 years

At the best the marl and sandstone soils of Montagny make Chardonnays that wed Chablis-like precision to ripeness levels that bring to mind well-made wines from the Cote de Beaune. Alain uses stainless steel and minimal oak to keep the wine bright and clean

7kms south of Beaune sits the pretty village of Monthelie and the splendid Chateau de Monthelie which Eric de Suremain inherited from his grandfather in 1983. Nothing is done by halves here and Eric converted to biodynamics in 1996. The vines are now in lovely balance and this shows through in the vibrant wines that are produced. The vineyards straddle the borders of Volnay and Meursault and are reputed to get more sunshine than other spots in Cote d'Or.

A lovely vinification and new oak casks have given this organic wine a deep purple colour, strawberry aromas and a great deal of finesse.





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KELLY'S SPECIAL SELECTION

Kelly's selection Red, White and Rose are "Appellation Controlee" wines from the Rhone Valley and Burgundy, and were specially labelled and bottled for Kelly's. The label was commissioned and painted by artist William Crozier. We also include special Table Wines from Chateauneuf area "Le Petit Vin d'Avril" and a dry white Chardonnay from Burgundy.
