Baby Preparation Room

This provides all the necessities for your child - includes milk, kettle, microwave, sterilizers and fridge. Nappy Bag bin provided. For any special foods required, please tell your Accommodation Assistant or the main Receptionist and they will do their best to assist you. The baby room is located on the ground floor beside room 50.

Babysitter

Our fully-equipped playroom for under 4's is located off the Ivy Room. Supervision by a qualified child carer at an hourly fee of €3 is available from 9am to 5.30pm.

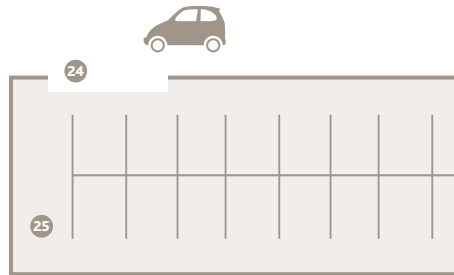

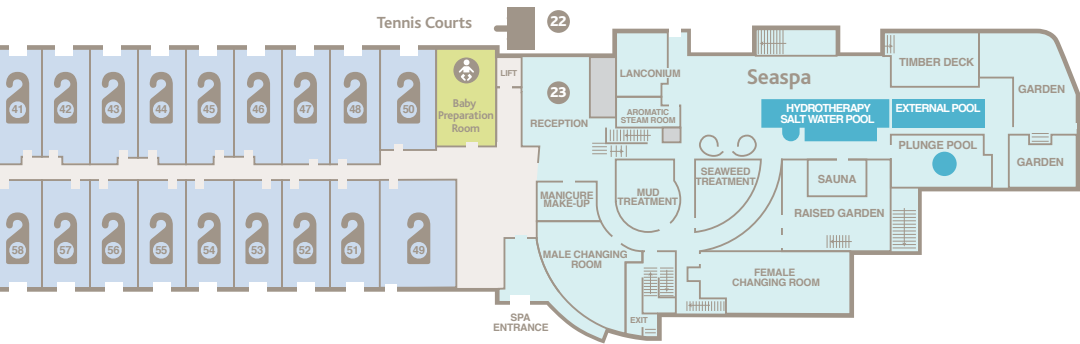
